Biblical Application:

Genesis 1:3

Matthew 5:14-16

- Where is our light (*reflection of Christ by being positioned in Christ*) supposed to shine according to verse sixteen?
- How do the people in darkness around us eventually get a true revelation of who God really is?
- Side Note: THREE COMMON RESPONSES TO THE LOST BY BELIEVERS, ONLY ONE IS CORRECT/CHRIST-LIKE...
  - EVADE the lost (run away, “be ye holy...”)
  - PERVADE the lost (overpower, “violent take it by force...”)
  - INVADE the lost (incarnate, “Greater is He who is in you, than...”)

1 John 1:5-10

- According to verse six, we are lying if we “say” we have fellowship with God, but “walk” in darkness. Who all are we lying to?

- What are the benefits of “walking” in the light in verse seven?
- According to verse nine, how does a believer remain in the light?
- If we ignore our sin, hide our sin or flat out deny we are sinning when we are sinning, who all is affected according to verses eight and ten?

#### 1 John 2:8-11

- What is the inevitable future of “darkness?”
- What dark behavior of a believer is described in these verses, and what affect does it have, especially in the overall attempt to lead people to Christ?

#### 1 John 2:15-17

- What problem can arise when a believer is trying to be a “light” in the world and also “love” the things of the world?
- How can this be remedied according to the end of verse seventeen?

#### Philippians 2:5-8

- *“...made Himself of NO REPUTATION”*
- *“...taking the form of a BONDSERVANT”*
- *“...He HUMBLLED HIMSELF”*
- *“...became OBEDIENT to the point of death..”*

#### Romans 13:11-14

*“And do this.....”*
